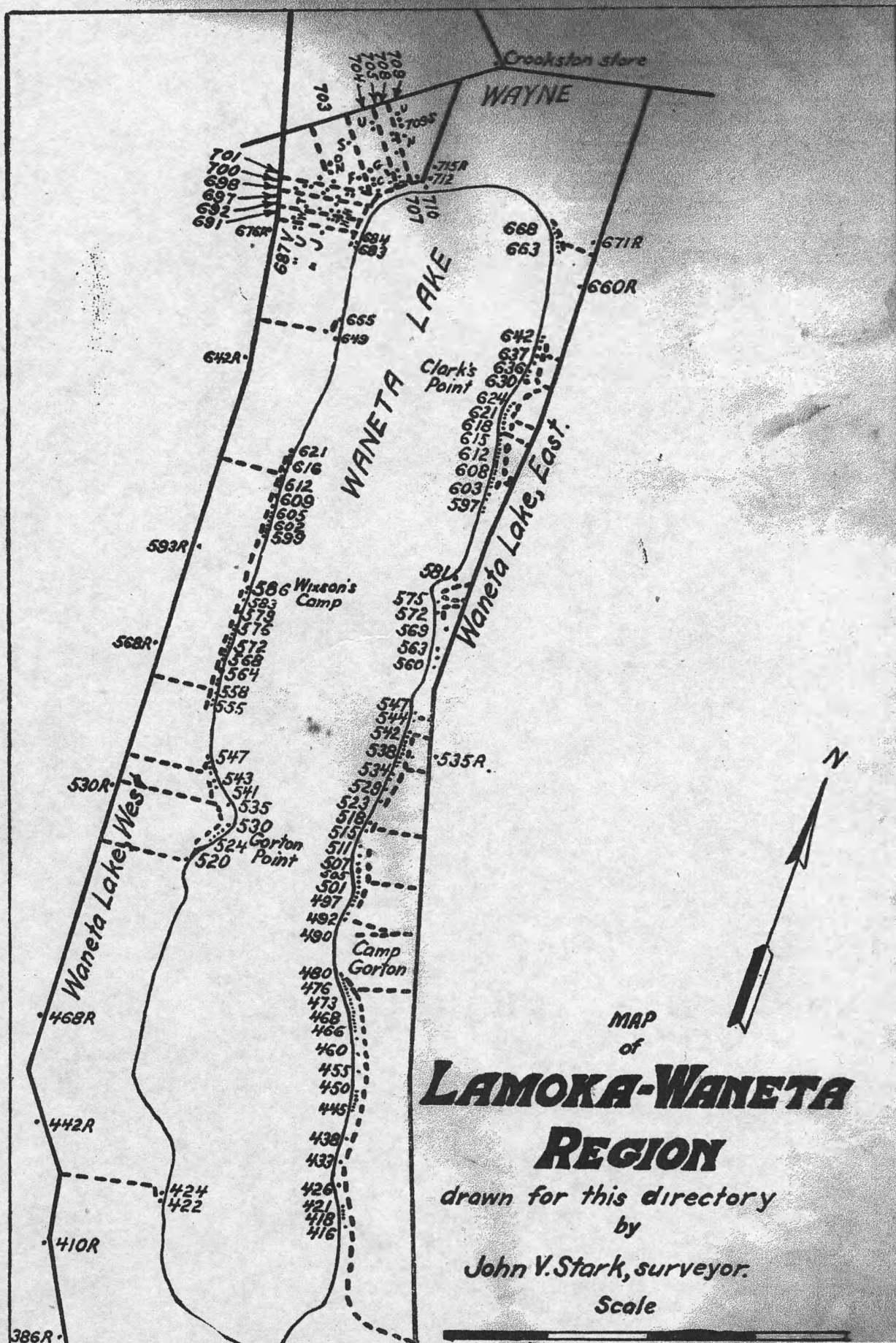

Lamoka - Waneta Lakes Association

The Lamoka-Waneta Lakes Association was formed in 1938 for the purpose of promoting the best interests of property owners and summer residents of the Lamoka-Waneta Lakes region or approximately the territory shown on the map on the page opposite.

The association will investigate any matter pertaining to the best interests of any group of its members that is brought to its attention by a member of the association.

The association is largely responsible for the maintenance of a suitable water level in the lakes, which means so much to bathers, fishermen and practically every user of the lakes. It was responsible for an electric gate being placed in the canal at the head of Waneta Lake to keep fish from swimming into the canal and going down the flume to destruction. This gate is an ingenious device that charges the water near it with radio wave impulses that drive away the fish without injuring them. The fish feel the electricity before coming in contact with the wires and turn around and swim back. Who knows but some of them take regular electric treatments for their health and thereby grow larger! This may account for some of the nice catches that have been made this year.

Through the efforts of the association those types of fishing through the ice that rob the lakes of fish in great numbers without benefitting any but a very few, have been prohibited by law. Now, only hand lines or angling are permitted when ice is on the lakes.

Accomplishments such as these can only be consummated through cooperative efforts. Every cottage owner and every summer resident should be a member of the association. The dues are only \$1.00 per year. Obviously, it is impractical to make a complete personal canvass for members as the time of the officers and active members is required to get things accomplished. Everyone should do his bit by seeing to it that his dues reach the secretary, Mr. Lloyd W. Fleet, 132R Lamoka Lake, East, or the president, Raymond V. Odell, 608 Waneta Lake, East. There are about 150 members at present. This should be 400. Any association activity with 400 members behind it has much greater power than with only 150 members behind it, particularly when the 400 represent nearly 100%.

At the present time the matter of, excessively noisy outboard motors is being investigated. Many other matters could properly come before the association. If you know of anything that affects any

group on either lake, do not sit back a just complain, but join the association yourself, get the others to do likewise and then place the matter before the association in the regular way. It holds regular meetings twice a year, —name the third Sunday in June and the third Sunday in August, but a special meeting can be called by the president at any time. The annual election of officers takes place at the August meeting.

A nice variety of fish is caught in the lakes:—

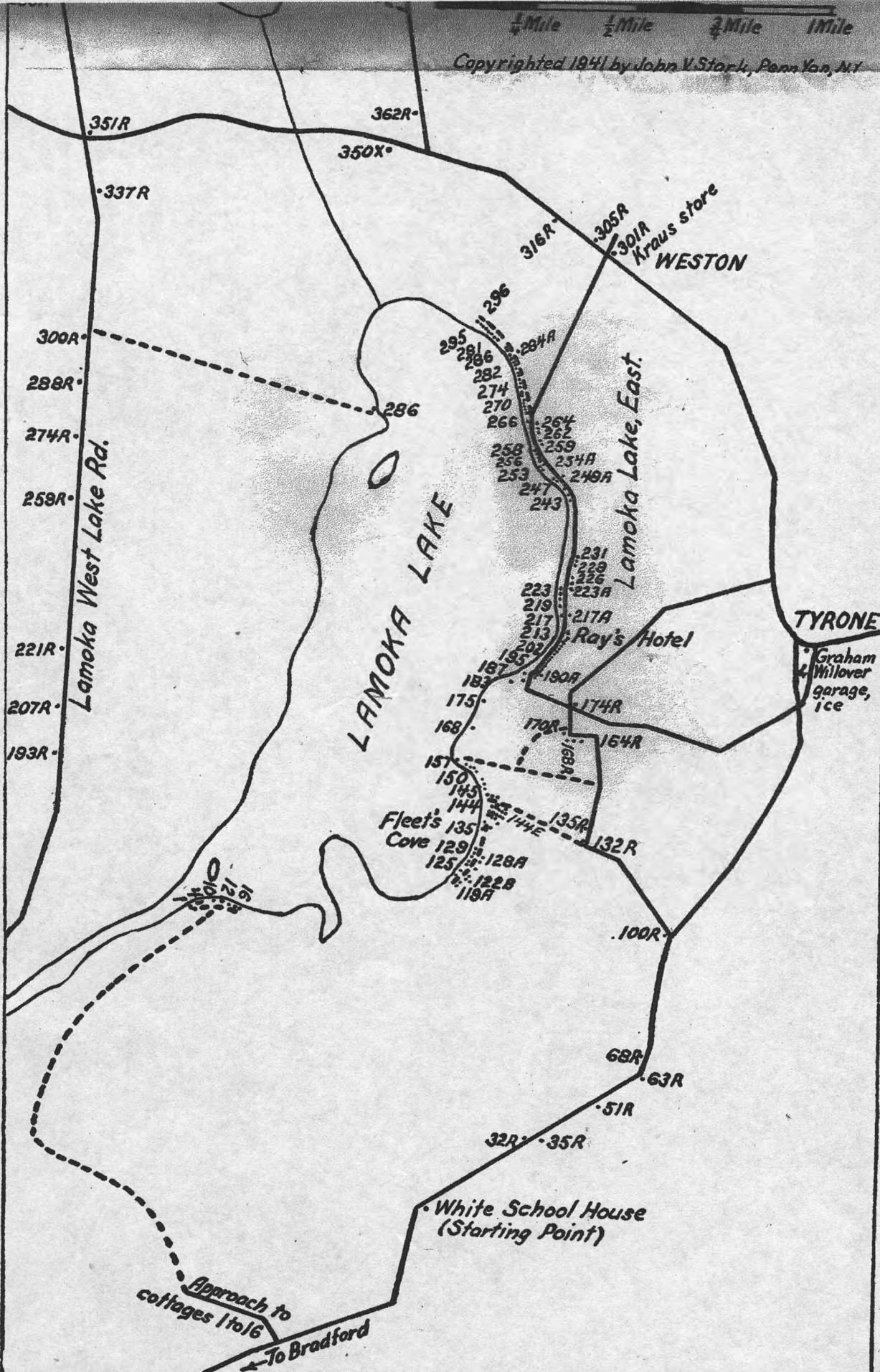
Oswego bass up to 4 lbs.
Black bass up to 3 lbs.
Calico bass up to 2 lbs.
Pickerel up to 30" long.
Perch up to 1½ lbs.
Bullheads up to 1 lb.
Pan fish.

The latest accomplishment of the association is this directory. John V. Stark, surveyor from Penn Yan, who numbers the cottages on Keuka and Seneca Lakes and made directories for both, was persuaded to come over here and install the same system on these lakes. The desirability of this is rapidly being realized. Many sections have had their numbers put up 100%. This directory speaks for itself.

Lamoka - Waneta Lake Directory

This directory gives the name and address of the owners of cottages on Lamoka and Waneta Lakes and of homes on the lake roads. The first section gives in alphabetical order the name of the owners and the usual occupant, his home address, the name of the cottage if it has one, and its number. y means the owner occupies it the year around. o means for owner's use. r means for rent. The name after the r is the one to whom it is rented. The name between * * is that of the owner. The name after the — is the cottage name.

This information has been given verbally by the reputed owner in 95% of the cases but it has not been checked from records. Numbers of places on the east side of either lake are followed by e; those on the west side by w. Any number on the east side pointed off to two places shows its distance from the outlet measured along the shore which is the same as its distance from the white school house down the Bradford road for all places north of where the lake road

nears the shore of Lamoka Lake. Any number on the west side pointed off to two places shows its distance from a point 3.5 miles south of the cross road between the lakes. (This point was arbitrarily chosen so as to make the same numbers on the east and west sides of Waneta Lake come opposite each other).

To save space, the abbreviation St. is omitted from addresses. E means Elmira, C means Corning. All home addresses are New York State unless otherwise noted.

R after the number means the place is on the road rather than the lake shore.

In the Silvan Beach section all places on the same side of the roads approximately perpendicular to the shore have the same number. The one on the shore has no letter, the first place across the lake road has A, the next B, the next C, etc. Approximately 50 feet is allotted for each letter omitting R. Thus, T, being the 20th letter or the 19th not counting R, would indicate the place about 950 feet

back. All places in the angle between 7 and 704 are numbered 703, the letter indicating the distance back from the lake road.

The second section gives in alphabetical order the named cottages, their owners and numbers.

The third section gives in geographical order the number of the cottages and homes, their owners and their names.

Signs showing the limiting number down any approach have been placed on the main roads. Thus anyone looking for cottage 608e would drive along the east lake road until he came to the sign reading 606-615. Going down this approach would find the first cottage marked 606, the next 607 and the next 608 or the one he wanted. If he wanted 700 Ow he would drive along the west lake road until he came to the sign reading 700-701. The first cottage on the south side of that street is 700U, the next 700T and the next 700 or the one he wanted.

Post Office Addresses

Places on the cross road between the lakes and south of it are Bradford, R. D. 1
Waneta Lake, East and Kraus store Dundee, R. D. 1
Waneta Lake, West Hammondsport, R. D. 1
Some of those near Wayne elect to get their mail at Wayne, N. Y.

In order to make possible a directory like this it has been necessary to measure the distance of every cottage and home from its respective starting point and to contact in person or by correspondence as many of the owners as possible. This has required a considerable amount of

traveling and expense. The installment of this system is paid back by each owner buying a number from him at the moderate price of 50c. This directory has been copyrighted. No one has a right to put up his number or to use it unless it has been purchased from John V. Stark,
